PRESIDENT OF THE JURY: DIRECTOR **ROBERTA TORRE**

The twenty-sixth edition of the **Terra di Siena International Film Festival** will bring the best of national and international cinema to the City of the Palio from 28 September to 2 October with the presentation as a special opening event of the film: "My hair hurts" by Roberta Torre , a tribute to Monica Vitti, with Alba Rohrwacher and Filippo Timi and an exceptional editing and costumes by the award-winning Massimo Cantini Parrini, nominated for the Oscars, who will hold a Master-class at the Festival for students relating to the "Mestieri del Cinema" project .

The opening evening will be preceded by a tribute dedicated to the composer Manuel De Sica with the recital "Words & Music" at the prestigious headquarters of the Accademia Musicale Chigiana in Siena.

There will also be the delivery of the special prize created by the Festival for the best soundtrack. The selection of the films in competition chosen by a team of experts led by the Artistic Director of the Festival Antonio Flamini will also look to Ukraine, to Russia with two films in absolute preview. The screenings of the films will all be presented at the Nuovo Pendola cinema in Via San Quirico in the historic center, while the Santa Maria della Scala Museum Complex will be the setting for retrospectives: one on Pierpaolo Pasolini and the other on Ugo Tognazzi in the centenary of his birth.

Two very great characters: the encounter with cinema and the intellectual, as in the work "Porcile" that will be screened. An "uncomfortable" film, but which will also be re-proposed for schools and introduce a "Prohibition to the Major" that the **Terra di Siena International Film Festival** wants to propose as well as other Pasolini films for the youngest and make them discover a character who has impressed an important mark in Italian culture and his lesson continues to speak to us with the sharp language of his writings and images, with the absolute originality of his visions, with the attention to marginalization, which in him expressed a desire for fullness human like Ugo Tognazzi instead gave comedy to cinema, but also the bitter laugh of the country's vices and hypocrisies.

To enrich the rich calendar of cinema screenings there will be matinees for secondary schools. There will also be the traditional Master-classes at the two prestigious Sienese Universities: University of Siena and University for Foreigners held by the filmmakers present in Siena who will deal with social issues and will deepen with the narration of the aforementioned issues raised, analysis of communication and market orientation.

The flagship will be the acting lessons held by two famous actors such as Pierfrancesco Favino and Barbara Enrichi.

The final evening with the award ceremony will be held at the Teatro dei Rozzi with a concert dedicated to Ennio Morricone.
